<p>A.C.T.S.</p>	<p>A.C.T.S. was started 8 years ago to provide support to local children and teenagers. They have a home on 13th Street where youth are welcomed, encouraged to build meaningful relationships and empowered to become leaders.</p> <p><i>Note: Yard Work - wear gloves and (optional) bring gardening tools Meal Prep - (optional) bring an apron. <p>Center for Women in Transition</p>	<p>The Center's mission is to respond to, reduce, and prevent domestic and sexual violence. This mission is achieved through education, collaboration and advocacy, with crisis and supportive services to victims and survivors.</p>
<p>Children's Advocacy Center</p>	<p>The Children's Advocacy Center provides programs and support services for child victims and their families, which enable them to heal emotionally and physically.</p>
